AN EVENT FOR SOLO, SIDECAR MOTORCYCLES AND QUADS, (ALL COMPETITORS MUST BE AGED 18 YEARS AND OVER) held under the National Sporting Code and Standing Enduro Regulations 2011 of the ACU, and these Supplementary Regulations and any further instructions that may be issued. **The event is a round of the 2011 British and ACU Sidecar Enduro, 2011 ACU Quad Enduro & 2011 ACU Twin Shock Championship, Sidecar Enduro Club.**

**Start:-** Will be in or close to the Dyfi Forest, Sign posted from the A470 between Machynlleth and Mallwyd at Cemmaes Road, Start Time will be 11.00 (Saturday) and 09.00 (Sunday)

**Route:-** Will be of forestry and farm land suitable for all classes (Similar to the 2009 Sunday Route) **DESIGNED FOR THE SPORTSMEN, CLUBMEN , There will be an OPEN Class for experts & championship that wish to compete. There may be a diversion for SIDECAR & QUAD COMPETITORS**, the number of laps will depend on the class entered. There will be designated fuel points on the route which will be clearly marked from the start area. (SPEEDS IN THE FORESTRY TO AND FROM THE START AND SERVICE POINTS AND SPECIAL TESTS WILL BE A MAXIMUM OF 15MPH/25KPH).

**Scrutineering:-** Will be from 09.00 to 10.45 on Saturday and 08.00 to 08.45 Sunday.

**Servicing:-** Competitors must use their own Environmental Mats at all service points.

**Washing Facilities:-** All forms of washing of machines and equipment (i.e. pressure washing) at this event are banned.

**Entries:-** Open on the 10<sup>th</sup> March 2011 and must be sent to the Secretary before the closing date of 20<sup>th</sup> May 2011 or when entries are full. All entries MUST be accompanied by 3 (THREE) Stamped Addressed Envelopes (C5 or A5 MAX SIZE). **Entry fee will only be returned if the event is cancelled or a valid Doctors Certificate is provided before the CLOSING DATE.** Then less £10 deduction for Organising costs. All Competitors must hold a current ACU Membership card or a SACU Licence. Competitors from other Countries within the EU including Irish participants must obtain personal accident insurance, produce a Licence issued by their FMN and start permission confirming they are licensed and insured.

**Priority for Entries:-** for the following ACU Championship Classes **Twin Shock, All Sidecar & Quad** classes will be to the **21<sup>st</sup> April 2011.**

**Fees:-** Both days Solo & Quads £115.00 Sidecar £115.00, One Day Only Solo £60.00, **No Sidecar , Quad OR T/Shock One Day Only Entries. CHEQUES MADE PAYABLE TO:- M W T R A Ltd (Entries from outside the UK to be paid in CASH when signing on in either Sterling or Euros)**

**Classes:- (ONLY ONE CLASS MAY BE ENTERED):- SOLO CLASSES:-** Sportsmen, Clubmen, Open , O/40, O/50, T/Shock  
**SIDECAR CLASSES:-** Championship, Clubmen. **QUAD CLASSES:-** Championship .  
(Only competitors holding a British passport will be able to score points in the ACU Championships)

**Special Tests:-** Will not be marked until 24hrs before start. They will be AUTOMATICALLY TIMED TO 0.003 of a second by ACU Timekeepers and Certified Equipment Using **ORION Transponders** Location of tests will be given at the start and may be inspected on FOOT only and **WILL BE RIDDEN ON THE FIRST LAP OF DAY ONE NOT TIMED.**

**Notice:-** Regulations when crossing bridleways & footpaths, these will be clearly marked and the riders must STOP and PUSH their machines across. If travelling along you MUST GIVEWAY to walkers and Horse riders and also OBEY ANY SPEED RESTRICTIONS, PENALTY for not complying EXCLUSION.

**Transponders:-** Orion transponders will be used, any transponder not returned within 7 days or DAMAGED at the end of the event the user will be charged £45 towards costs of replacement.

**Awards:-** Premier Trophy:- Best performance in each class, Best Lady Driver, Best O/40 Solo, Best /50 Solo, Best T/Shock, Gold Medals, Silver Medals, Bronze Medals.
